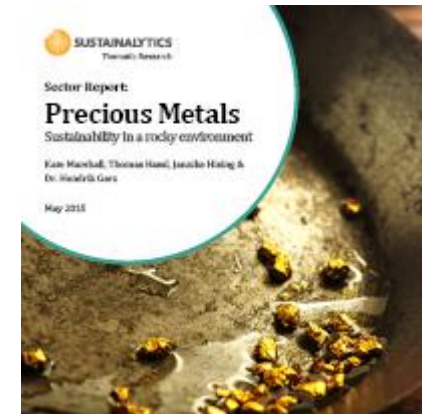

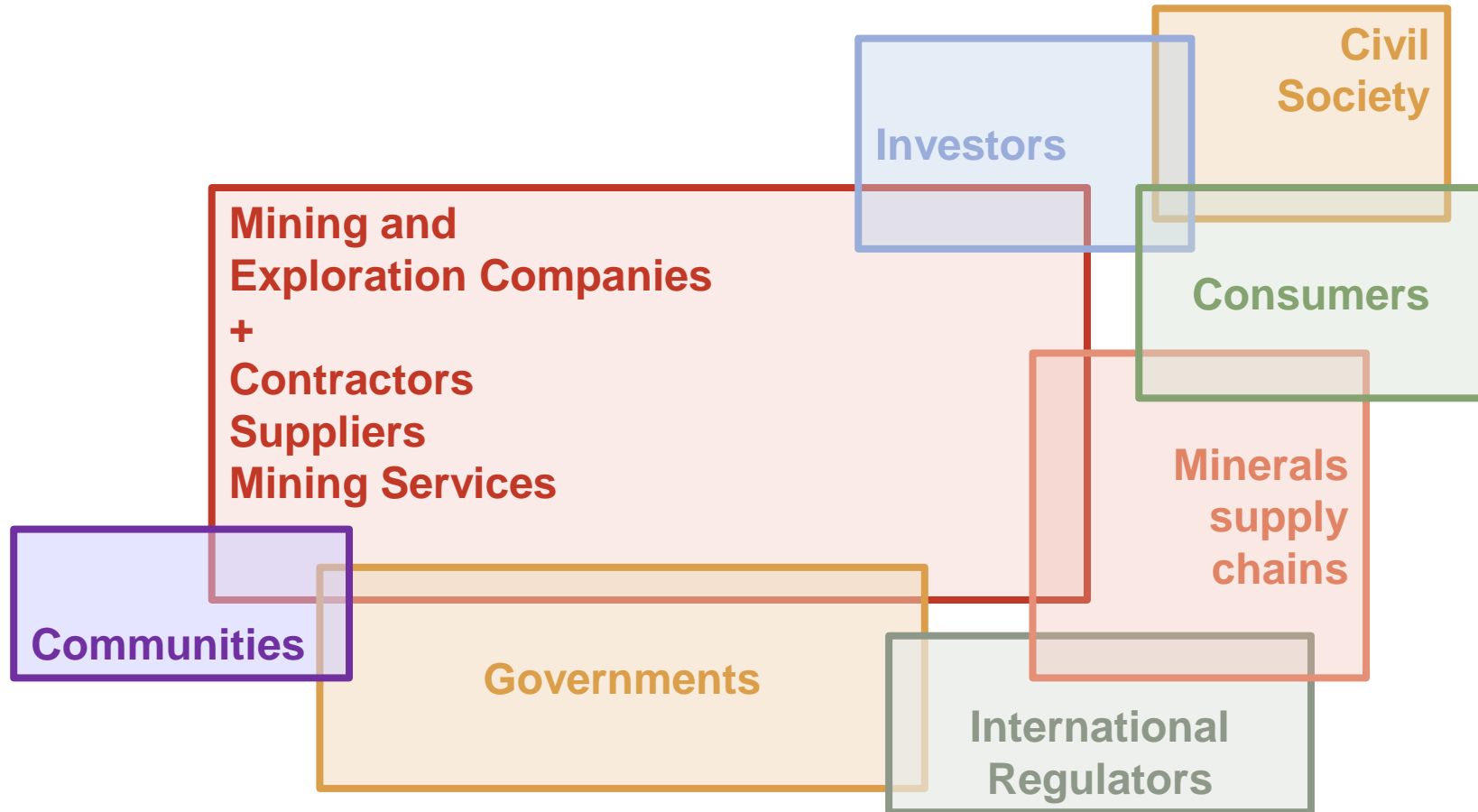

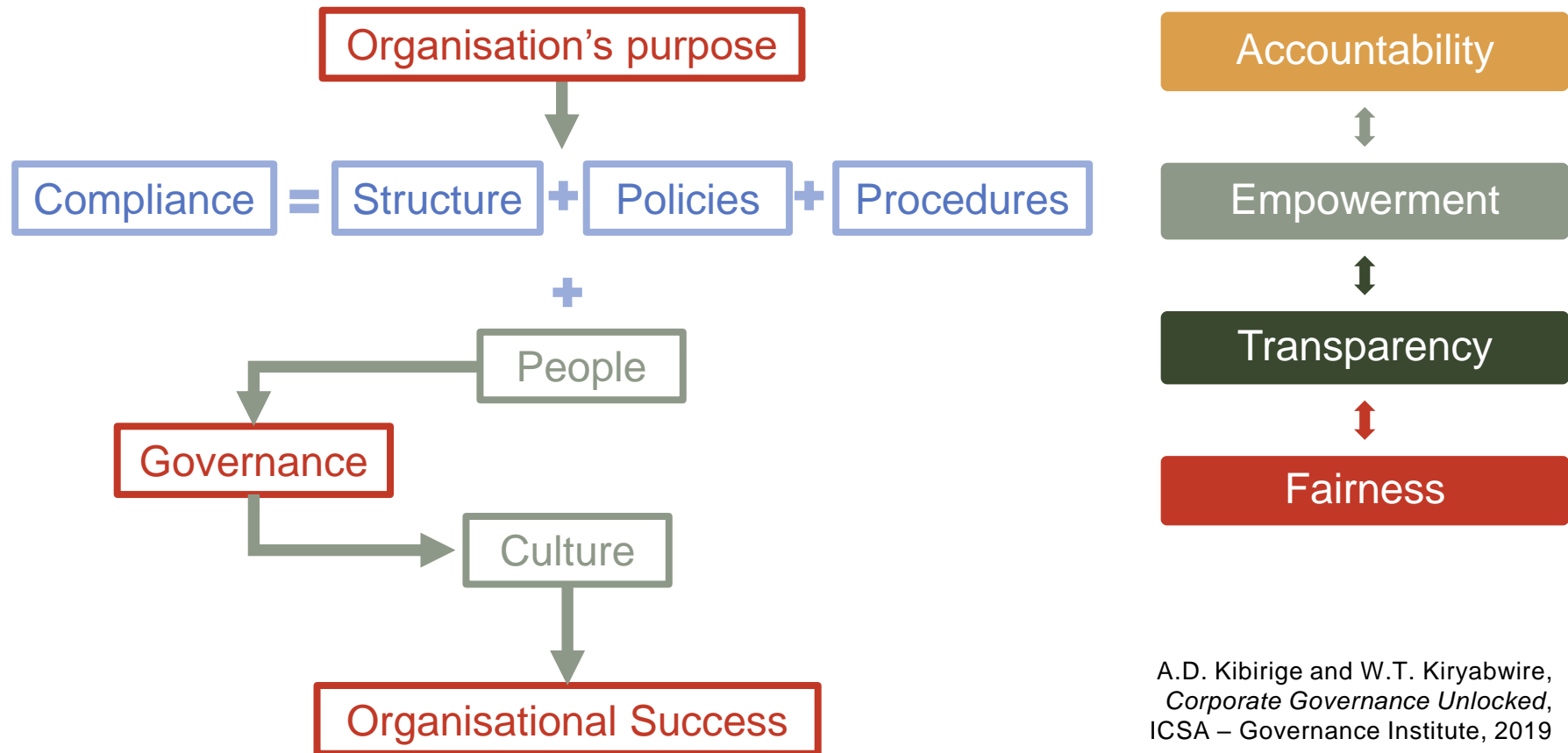
Corporate Governance



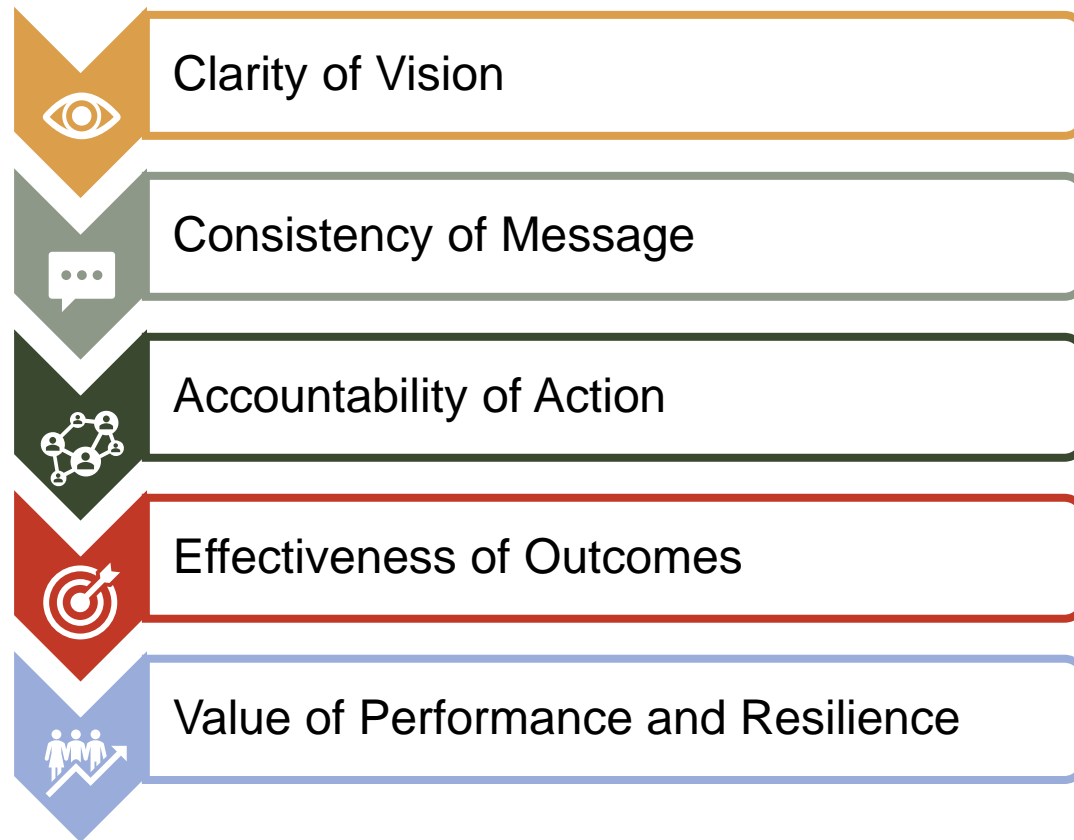
